

How to get to Örebro

From **Copenhagen** (Kastrup) and **Malmö** (Sturup) there are direct flights to Örebro. From **Örebro Airport** you easily get to Örebro by taking a taxi. A trip to Örebro city center costs about SEK 250. The taxi companies below offers a standard rate. There is a taxi ramp outside the terminal. You can also book a taxi in advance or use the taxi phone by the entrance. All taxis accept credit card payment.

From **Stockholm** (Arlanda) and **Stockholm** (Bromma), you make your journey either by airport shuttle bus or train to Stockholm C (central railway station), from where several trains per hour leave for Örebro (Swedish rail website : www.sj.se).

From **Stockholm** (Skavsta) the most convenient way to get to Örebro is by taxi (Taxi Kurir offers fixed fares). If you are a small group an alternative could be to book a small bus (10 persons) for the price of 2220 SEK (224 Euro) at Kjells resetjänst +46 (0)19 22 68 86.

Returning from Örebro

Participants catching morning flights from the Stockholm airports (e.g. on Saturday 6 November) must bear in mind the train journey from Örebro to Stockholm. For some it may be advisable to spend the night before in Stockholm city (for hotels, see www.booking.com) or near the airports (see <http://stockholm.airporthotelguide.com>). Alternatively, small groups can share a minibus from Örebro to the airport(s).
